Wondering about basic needs budgeting?

UO's Financial Aid and Scholarships estimates the cost of attendance for graduate students. Basic needs are estimated at \$1,286 for housing and \$420 for food. This does not include transportation, miscellaneous personal expenses, or your course materials, which can vary. Create a budget with free tools from UO so that you know what to expect.
