


Dear McDerBern,

## **First Steps**

- Submit your official transcripts
- Claim your <u>Duck ID</u>

- Know the <u>tuition and fees</u> for your program
- Review page 8 of the <u>International Student Arrival Handbook</u> as you begin the search for housing. Start familiarizing yourself with the area around campus and plan to respond quickly
- Optional <u>Temporary homestay</u>
