## **Health Requirements**

## **Financial Requirements**

- · Read and accept Student Billing account terms.
- Review page 18 in the International Student Arrival Handbook.
- Estimate your monthly budget to prepare for the cost of attending and continue saving as much as possible beforehand for unexpected expenses.
- Stay informed about <u>scholarships</u> and <u>support</u> for international graduate students.
- · Financial coaching is available free to UO students.



## Wondering about basic needs budgeting?

UO's Financial Aid and Scholarships estimates the <u>cost of attendance</u> for graduate students. Basic needs are estimated at \$1,286 for housing and \$420 for food. This does not include transportation, miscellaneous personal expenses, or your course materials, which can vary. <u>Create a budget</u> with free tools from UO so that you know what to expect.
